
Fine-grained Permissions

\*Plone is a Web CMS (WCMS) Tool (CMS for managing websites/web content)



Visual Comparison of Revision Differences


Management of Metadata (tags, keywords, pub dates, author, credits, other)

# Additional CMS Features

Extensible (available add-on modules or custom dev)

Allows for Custom Themes

SEO-Friendly (helps with search engine rankings)

Portlet Management (arrange widgets on page)

Dashboard (recent edit/publish activity at-a-glance)

Useful Built-in Templates (page, news, event listings, thumbnail layouts, etc.)


Plays Nicely With Others (SSO, LDAP/AD, Salesforce, legacy Oracle/SQL Server DBs)

Provides Maintenance Scripts/Features (Database backup/restore, restarts, etc.)

Reasonable Upgrade Options







- **ECM** Enterprise Content Management (DMS/WCM/multi-channel/integrations)

# Specialized Tools vs. CMS Add-on

Wiki - wild west of self-publishing; little editorial control

Blog - your sometimes lengthy thoughts, but with threaded comments

Forums - interactive discussions amongst many members (plus anonymous, sometimes); sometimes moderated, sometimes not
